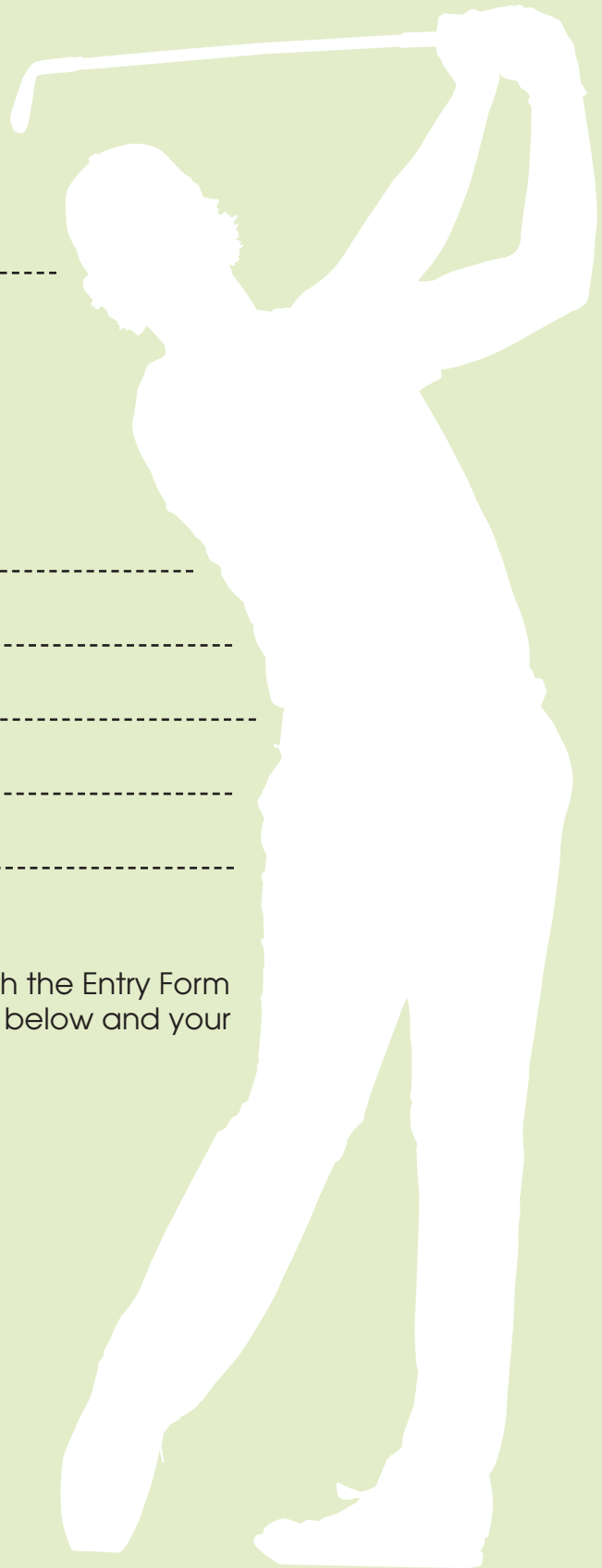
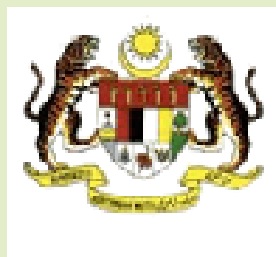

Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations relating to the Golf tournament shall be read in conjunction with the principal Rules.

1. MODE OF PLAY

Stableford

The mode of play for the competition will be based on the Stableford form of stroke competition. The reckoning for the Stableford competition is made by points awarded in relation to a fixed score at each hole as follows:

For hole completed in one over par	1 point
For hole completed in par	2 points
For hole completed in one under par	3 points
For hole completed in two under par	4 points
For hole completed in three under par	5 points

Any hole for which a competitor fails to score shall be regarded as a wipe.

Scoring cards

The holes at which strokes are to be given or taken shall be indicated on the card issued by the committee.

Recording scores

The marker shall be responsible for marking only the gross number of strokes at each hole and its stableford value.

2. HANDICAP

The maximum handicap allowed will be 24 for men and 36 for women. All participants shall declare their lowest handicap on the entry form. The committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps accordingly.

3. ABIDING RULES

The tournament will be played in accordance with the rules of Golf approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews (R&A), United States Golf Association (USGA) and the local rules of the Vines Resort and Country Club.

4. DISPUTES

The tournament committee shall be responsible for all matters affecting play. Cases of disputes and grievances regarding the competition shall be referred to the tournament committee and resolved in accordance with the rules of golf as stated above. The decision of the committee shall be final.

5. STARTING TIMES

The competition will commence on shotgun start at 08.00hrs. Competitors are required to report to the official starter fifteen (15) minutes before the starting time. Failure to start on time will result in their disqualification and any fee paid is not refundable.

6. INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather, the tournament committee in consultation with the General Committee may:

a) Reschedule the starting time if such inclement weather precedes and continues past the original starting time

b) Decide to abandon play if such inclement weather makes starting of play or continuance of play impossible. In either event, all participants will be kept informed of the committee's decision.

7. FLIGHT ARRANGEMENT

The tournament committee, assisted by the officials of the Golf Club, will carry out pairing of participants. Request for change of flight arrangement will not be entertained and the committee reserves the right to change the pairing if warranted.

8. APPROVED BALLS

The ball the participants use should conform to the 1.68" Golf balls approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and USGA.

9. FORM OF PLAY

The competition will be decided by stableford points over 18 holes.

10. PRIZES

The major prize of a return air ticket to Kuala Lumpur will be awarded to the winner of a lucky draw of golfers' cards. The outright winner of the tournament will be awarded the Challenge Trophy as well as the first prize of a substantial value. It is the committee's intention to award every player a prize.

In addition, novelty prizes will be awarded for the following:

Nearest to the Pin	2 prizes
Hole in One	2 prizes
Longest Drive	2 prizes
Nearest to the Line	2 prizes

Except for the novelty prizes all participants can only win one prize.

Please note: that it is important to declare your true handicap.
